

The statements provided below are true to the best of my ability

In the late summer of 2006 my husband and I were out at a local bar. We had observed Richard Reiss and G [redacted] Reiss sitting a booth. It was fairly late at night and I was concerned for my grandchild G [redacted]. I became especially concerned with I observed that Richard Reiss had a gun attached to his belt. Richard was drinking alcohol and began lining up bullets on the table. I then approached Richard and informed him that he cannot do that in a public area and that he had G [redacted] with him which wasn't a smart thing. I was told by the server that waited on us that Richard had been coming into the bar with G [redacted] frequently because he seemed to take a liking to one of the other servers. During the course of the evening I had noticed that Richard and G [redacted] were gone. I asked around to see if anyone had noticed that they left but without any luck. At the end of the evening my husband and I decided that we would go to Denny's for some breakfast. It was then that we saw Richard and G [redacted] eating. This was approximately 2:30am.

In the early time of 2006 Richard Reiss called my cell phone and informed me that he and G [redacted] were in town and wanted to know if I wanted to see G [redacted]. I stated that I would very much like to. We agreed to meet a fast food restaurant and a specific time. My husband and I meet Richard and G [redacted]. This is the first time that I had seen G [redacted] since he was a baby. We spent some time together and I asked Richard if I could spend some time with G [redacted]. He stated yes but that I couldn't have G [redacted] talk to Desiree because it would be uncomfortable for G [redacted]. When I asked Richard what he tells G [redacted] when he asks about his mother, Richard informed me that G [redacted] never asks.

I spent several times with G [redacted]. One specific time was when Richard asked if I would keep G [redacted] while he went to California. Richard informed me that he would return before the evening however at the time that Richard was suppose to pick up G [redacted], Richard called to inform me that his motorcycle had broken down and he didn't know when he was going to be able to get there. I kept G [redacted] over night. I actually called out for work as I didn't know when Richard was going to be there. Richard called me in the morning to tell me that he was at their apartment in Phoenix and asked if I could drop G [redacted] off of which I did.

On one visit when G [redacted] visited with me, I did allow my daughter Desiree to speak with G [redacted] as I felt she needed to be aware of what was going on. She was living in Florida at the time and could not make it to Phoenix is such short notice.

The next time that we were going to spend some time together was G [redacted]'s birthday September 27, 2006 and Richard and I had agreed that we would meet at an indoor amusement place to celebrate. I had gone out and purchased presents for G [redacted]. Richard and G [redacted] never showed up. I called several times. I went to Richards's apartment after two days of trying to call him only to find the apartment empty (I looked through the window and it was bare). That was the last time I saw G [redacted].

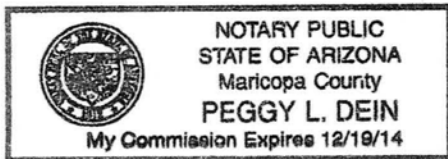
